## **Hospital Bag Checklist**

Here's what you need to bring for your hospital stay:

	Clinic card or records from doctor's office
	Insurance card
	Labor aids if desired (pillow, oils/lotion, music, massage aids)
	Camera or cell phone (include chargers or batteries)
	Baby book (items you want footprinted)
	Overnight bag with daily care needs
	Toiletries: shampoo, conditioner, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, hair ties, makeup if desired
	Glasses and contacts
	Comfortable change of clothes (gowns, pajamas - two sets)
	Slippers - socks
	Nursing bras
Nor	thwest provides disposable underwear, sanitary pads, and nursing pads during your stay.
	Maternity outfit to wear home
	(you will be approximately the size you were at about 28 weeks of pregnancy)
	Baby outfit and receiving blanket to go home in
Nor	thwest provides diapers, wipes, pacifiers, formula, onesies and receiving blankets during your stay.
	Infant car seat (be sure to have the car seat already installed properly prior to being
	discharged from the hospital)
	ease do not bring baby lotions, powders, oils or clippers.
The	se items are unnecessary during your hospital stay.

You can expect to be in the hospital an average of 24-48 hours after a non-complicated vaginal delivery and approximately 48-72 hours after a cesarean section. These time frames are only an estimate. Your healthcare provider will discuss your actual plan of care at delivery.
